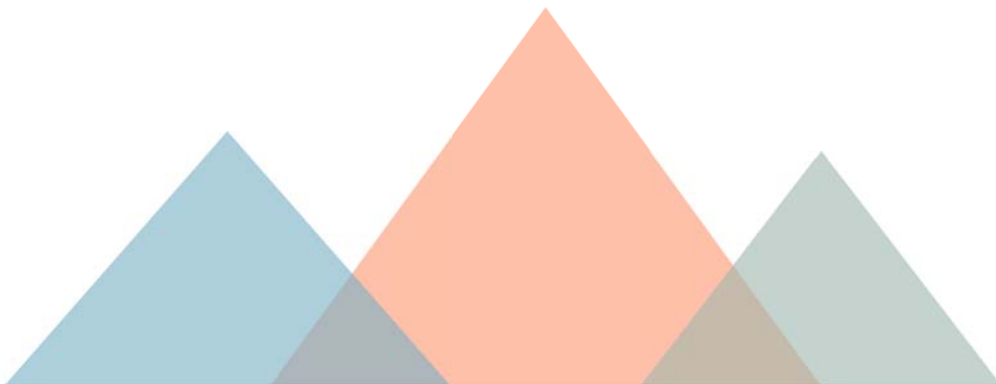

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Decisions that Shape Pyramid Colorado

UNITY & INCLUSION

Unify Colorado's approach by using the national Pyramid modules and other resources while ensuring continued emphasis on inclusion

QUALITY & FIDELITY

Maintain Colorado's certification process; revisit and refresh

PARTNERSHIP & INTEGRATION

Create a nimble but strong structure of partnerships; alignment with early childhood workforce systems

Pyramid Colorado is hosting a series of huddles to support trainers, coaches, demonstration sites, and implementation communities.

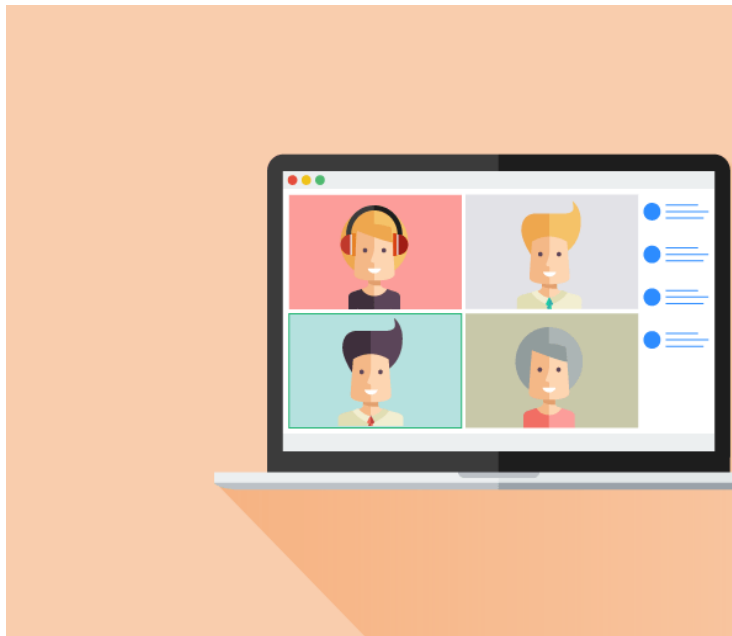
What is a huddle?

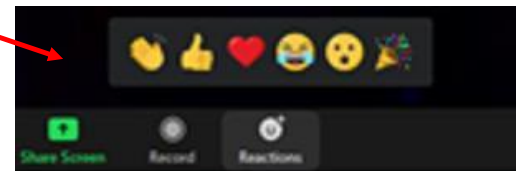


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Using Zoom Reactions

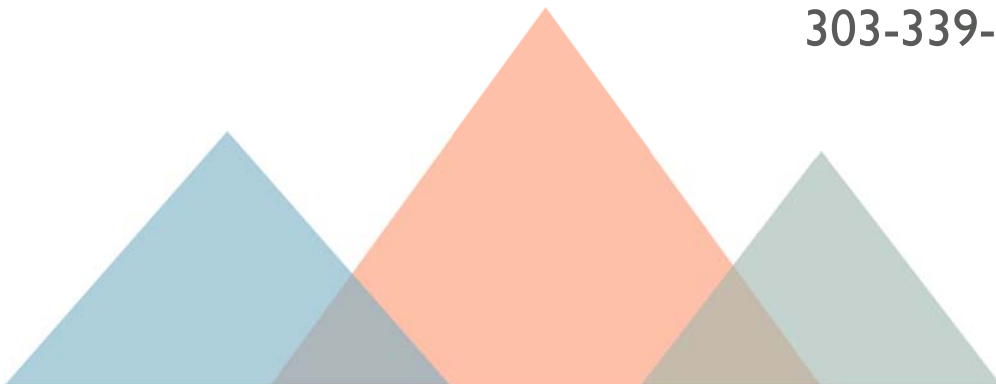
