Certification Description

The Pyramid Colorado Facilitator Certification is an intentional professional development pathway designed to support professionals in their efforts to improve and support the capacity of state systems, communities, and local programs that implement the Pyramid Model. The Pyramid Model is an early childhood multi-tiered system of support to improve the social, emotional, and behavioral outcomes of young children with, and at-risk for, developmental disabilities or delays. Additionally, this Certification seeks to align with the Colorado Shines Professional Development Information System.

This certification will prepare you to deliver Pyramid Model training, utilize observation tools and provide coaching on Pyramid practices, as well as build relationships with other Pyramid practitioners across the state.

- A brief virtual interview may be requested and would occur by August 13, 2021
- You will receive notification of the status of your application by August 17, 2021
- Submit a completed agreement and payment on or before August 31, 2021
