- Ensure responsible planning and stewardship of resources

Promote Pyramid-related work through communications and tools

- Provide opportunities for input and ensure timely communication about relevant updates, evidence-based, and promising practices
- Launch updated Pyramid 'badge' and branding materials
- Provide various tools and templates with updated branding
- Update and maintain the online Pyramid resource center content, functionality, and increase engagement
- Disseminate the Annual Impact Report

Conduct outreach and provide engagement opportunities

- Build general awareness of the impact of Pyramid Model implementation
- Conduct outreach efforts to be responsive to local needs and interests and to build awareness, participation, and connection
- Create awareness and connections with other consultative and coaching roles

Catalyze sharing of innovative, local solutions

- Create a culture of sharing and co-creating innovative solutions for initiating and strengthening implementation in local communities and programs
- Foster and maintain positive peer relationships

Learning & Implementation

Develop an evaluation plan aligned with desired results

- Create and rollout an updated comprehensive evaluation plan
- Support local, state, and national evaluation efforts
- Promote the sharing and utilization of data-informed decisions

Ongoing learning knowledge and skill acquisition

- Offer ongoing technical assistance, professional development, Summit
- Convene Communities of Practice for Facilitators and practitioners
- Develop, launch, and evaluate the PSfF Trainer Endorsement
- Explore *Unpacking the Pyramid Model* training series to support ongoing practice and implementation

Provide services to support high quality, ongoing implementation

- Transition from Pyramid Plus Approach to Colorado Pyramid Model training
- Clarify and communicate the 4 different Pyramid Model implementation intensities (1. Exploring, 2. Practicing, 3. Fidelity, 4. Model)
- Develop and administer Pyramid ARPA projects
- Develop a model for Community-Level implementation expectations and supports

Administer the Pyramid Facilitator Certification

- Evaluate and modify the Facilitator Certification content and processes
- Develop and rollout Facilitator Certification Continuation requirements/criteria
- Deliver the Facilitator Certification using a cohort model

Leadership & Advocacy

Build an active and collaborative leadership structure

- Facilitate a SLT that adheres to processes and includes policy/systems and implementation/practice perspectives
- Convene 4 workgroups to inform and guide the Network Hub

Pursue greater systems integration and workforce development

- Partner to create alignment within early childhood systems and related initiatives in Colorado
- Advocate for improving and expanding qualification pathways in Colorado's early childhood professional development system

Elevate voices to advocate for local needs, best practices, state systems, and national models for social and emotional well-being

- Facilitate opportunities for engagement in policy and advocacy efforts
- Catalyze a movement supporting expansion, innovation, and sustainability
- Develop leadership skills, deep expertise, and passion that results in a vibrant, healthy, and engaged network of stakeholders
- Use data and stories to advocate for expansion of and sustainable funding for state, community, and program level Pyramid implementation efforts
- Ensure alignment with state and national systems to reduce barriers
- Represent Colorado's Pyramid Network Hub at state and national levels
